slang synonyms: to fold, to knuckle under, to eat dirt or humble pie, to pull in one's horn, to lie down and roll over, to roll over and play dead

to take a big risk or chance, to risk it all
to dare, to venture

informal synonyms: to walk on a tightrope,
to throw caution to the wind, to stick out
one's neck, to go out on a limb

informal synonyms: to give a whirl, to have a fling at, to stick one's neck in the noose, to go on the hook for, to skate on thin ice

to gesture, gesticulate, motion or
wave with one's arms

to hold someone in one's arm, to hug,
to embrace, to take someone in one's arms

to offer one's arm to

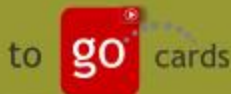
to give support to, to help or aid someone who has problems walking (i.e. **to offer one's arm to one's elderly parent**)
