# body

physical structure and material substance of a human being and an animal, including bones, flesh and organs

# body

corporeal structure, bulk, built, figure, shape  
The shape of a woman's **body** is different  
from culture to culture.

# body

framework, skeleton, flesh and bone, trunk, torso  
The **body** without flesh and bone is a skeleton.

# body

carcass, corpse, cadaver, remains  
Once a **body** no longer contains life it is  
called a corpse.

# body

(slang for a dead body) stiff  
Get the **body** out of here.

# body

person, human being, creature

I need to know how many **bodies** are present to decide on how much food to make.

# body

majority, greater part, bulk, lion's part  
The **body** of the population doesn't vote.

# body

core, crux, essence, heart, kernel

The **body** of the argument makes no sense.

# body

group, collectivity, mass, corps, band  
They voted as a **body**.

(work) work party, detail, force

# body

(military) force, detachment, squadron, army  
troops, division, unit

# body

group, crowd, gathering, community of  
worshippers, collection, congregation, assembly

# body

(informal) body, band, throng, mob,  
gang, crowd, horde

# body

(animals) flock, herd, school, pride, gaggle,  
drove, bevy, covey, swarm, colony

body

density, firmness, consistency

# body

lushness, richness, shine, sheen, thick,  
healthy and full of luster

I love your hair. It has so much **body**.

to make substantial, to furnish with a body

# to body

to embody, to actualize, to substantiate,  
to personate, to incarnate

# to body

to become part of, to combine, to unite,  
to blend, to join, to mingle

## body and soul

completely, totally, positively, to the utmost,  
wholly, fully, fervently, thoroughly, absolutely  
She fought **body and soul** to achieve her goal.

## body and soul

(informal) nothing short of, heart and soul,  
whole hog, to the hilt, inside and out

## body and soul

(slang) like mad or crazy, stock and barrel,  
hook, line and sinker

# body art

the painting, tattooing or mutilation of the body

# body blow

hard hit, during a fight, to the area  
between the neck and waist

# body blow

serious loss, disappointment, defeat

# body blow

(informal) to be let down, a bitter pill, a comedown, slap in the face or rebuff

# body builder

one who exercises to put one body in optimum shape, usually for a competition  
She looks so good because she is a **body builder**.

# body building

the act of putting one's body in optimum shape usually for a competition

# body check

blocking an opponent by hitting, striking  
or impacting him or her with the body

She gave him a **body check**. He won't be  
bothering her again.

# body check

to collide with or crash against or into one's  
opponent with one's body

# body check

(informal) to bang into, slam or pummel one's opponent with one's body

# body clock

the system which controls the biological function of the body

A woman's **body clock** determines if and when she has a baby.



# body color

an opaque or non-transparent pigment, color, coloring, tint or hue

# body corporation

a person, association or group of persons  
legally incorporated, a company or  
partnership which is a single entity

# body count

the number of soldiers or civilians who are  
dead after a violent confrontation

I don't believe the **body count** given by  
the media.



## body count

the number of persons who are dead after a serious accident (i.e. fire or hurricane)

The **body count** after the hurricane was very high.

# body double

used in movies to substitute an actor, usually in nude scenes

## body English (British English)

the manner which one moves or twists one's body after they have thrown or hit the ball as if that movement can influence where the ball lands

# bodyguard

a person employed to protect someone (usually a celebrity or high-level government official)

# body image

the representation, in one's mind, of how one's body is or should be

# body language

the way that one carries one's body to silently and unconsciously communicate what one feels

# body odor

the bad or unpleasant smell of the body

# body of believers

Christians, members of the Christian church,  
community of believers

# Body of Christ

assembly of Christians for the purpose of worship



# Body of Christ

the consecrated bread of the Eucharist,  
the holy communion

# body of facts

body of information or law

collection of general information, facts,

panel of peer, jury, panel of one's peers
